OVERVIEW

The Annual Interstate Police Fishing Competition (IPFC) is held at Coffs Harbour and is run from the premises of the Coffs Harbour Yacht Club. The event has been ongoing between NSW, QLD and AFP fishing Clubs. Because of this, the event has been dubbed the 'Tri State' and has offered intense competition between clubs and States and lasting friendships. The 2021 Tri state will be organised and hosted by the ACU Police Fishing Club and is open to all Australian Police and emergency service's workers, friends and family.

SCHEDULE

Sunday 5 May 2024	1200 hrs. Briefing/Registration. At location to be advised near boat ramp/harbour.....Fishing commences 1pm
Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday 6, 7, and 8 May.	Fishing continues. Weigh station opens between 1500hrs and 1600 hrs daily.
Thursday 9 May 2024	Fishing finishes at 1200 hrs. All fish to be inside weigh station no later than 1300 sharp. No exceptions.

RULES

- Fishing commences from 1300hrs on Sunday 5 My 2024 and concludes at 12.00 hrs on Thursday 9 May 2024.
- The weigh master will be available at the weigh in area from 1600 hrs to 1700hrs, Monday to Wednesday and 1200hrs to 1300hrs on Thursday. Alternatively, score sheets can be texted to the weigh master.
- Vessels fishing offshore are to be launched from Coffs Harbour boat ramp and must log on and off with Marine Rescue using the call sign allocated at registration/briefing.
- Vessels fishing inshore must fish east of Pacific HWY, no further South than the Nambucca River and no further north than Moonee Creek. All fish landed in the competition must be caught under the following conditions:
 - Caught on either hand line or rod and reel.
 - A maximum of four (4) lines per competitor.
 - A maximum of two (2) hooks or one (1) rig per line may be in use at any one time.
 - Presented for recording as caught (Gut and Gill intact) or photographed on a brag mat for verification of size.
 - Caught without the assistance of other persons other than an assistant may gaff, gill or net a fish once it is subdued.
 - Caught within the geographical boundaries of the competition.
 - Caught within the time limits of the competition.
 - Fishing from boats and/or shore is permitted.
 - Fishing with bait, lure or fly.
- All anglers must have a current NSW fishing licence issued by the Department of primary Industries/Fisheries.
- All State Fishing rules and regulations and Waterways regulations must be strictly adhered to.

- The competition will be on a length basis.
 - Points will be allocated as follows:
 - Ten points for each legal size fish caught.
 - Two (2) bonus points per 5 cms over legal length
- A total of 5 of each species per angler per day may be submitted for point scoring. For species that have a bag limit of less than 5 fish per angler that will apply for scoring purposes.
- All fish measured must comply with the minimum specified length as prescribed from time to time by NSW Fisheries and in any case be no less than 30cm, including unlisted species.
- A more comprehensive list of rules will be supplied to each angler prior to competition start.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

The skipper of each vessel to complete the angler entry form on behalf of his/her crew and also the presentation dinner notification form. **Do not send any monies with these forms.** Angling fees and presentation dinner monies are to be paid at the briefing as per schedule. The skipper of each vessel is to register his/her crew at the briefing prior to commencing fishing and finalise all payments. A call sign will be allocated to each vessel at the briefing.

For those attending the **presentation dinner** please indicate by completing the dinner notification. **You may attend the presentation dinner without necessarily competing in the fishing event.**

For those anglers intending to fish strictly from shore or beach, simply complete the entry form filling out crew member/angler details only and striking out boat and skipper details.

GENERAL NOTICE/WARNINGS

Event participants are warned that involvement in this event is a 'recreational activity', within the meaning of the Civil Liability Act 2002 and that the pursuit of such activities may result in personal harm or injury. All persons who engage in a recreational activity do so at their own risk.

It is the responsibility of the individual to know and ensure that:

- Vessels are registered, seaworthy and comply strictly with the NSW Waterways legislation for the intended area of operation.
 - Vessels are adequately insured for their intended use against theft, damage, personal injury and liability.
- Details supplied on the Angling entry form will be forwarded to Marine Rescue Coffs Harbour for the purpose of **Safety of life at Sea (SOLAS)** only
